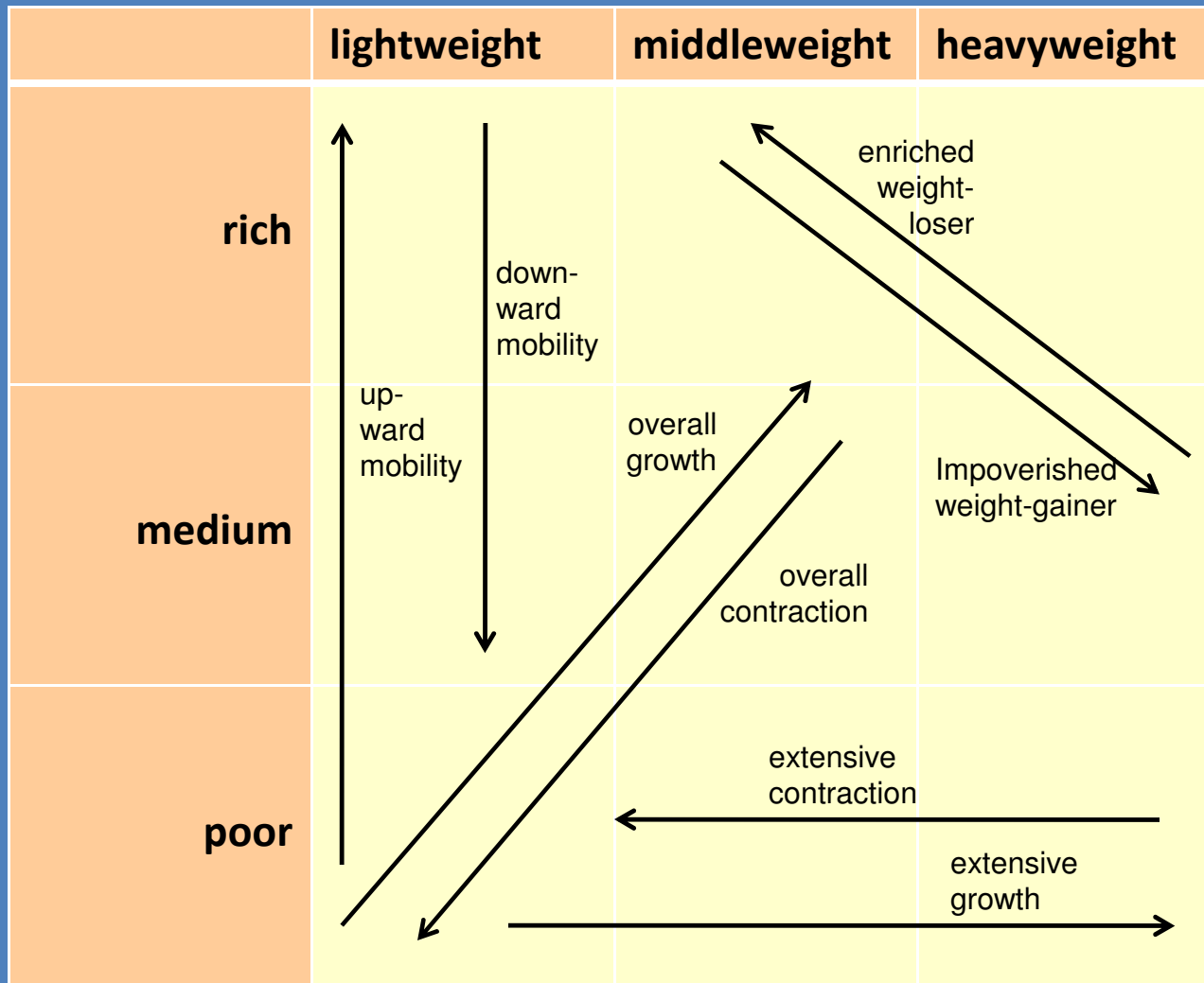

(Computed from Maddison 2001. Labels indicate earliest datapoint.)

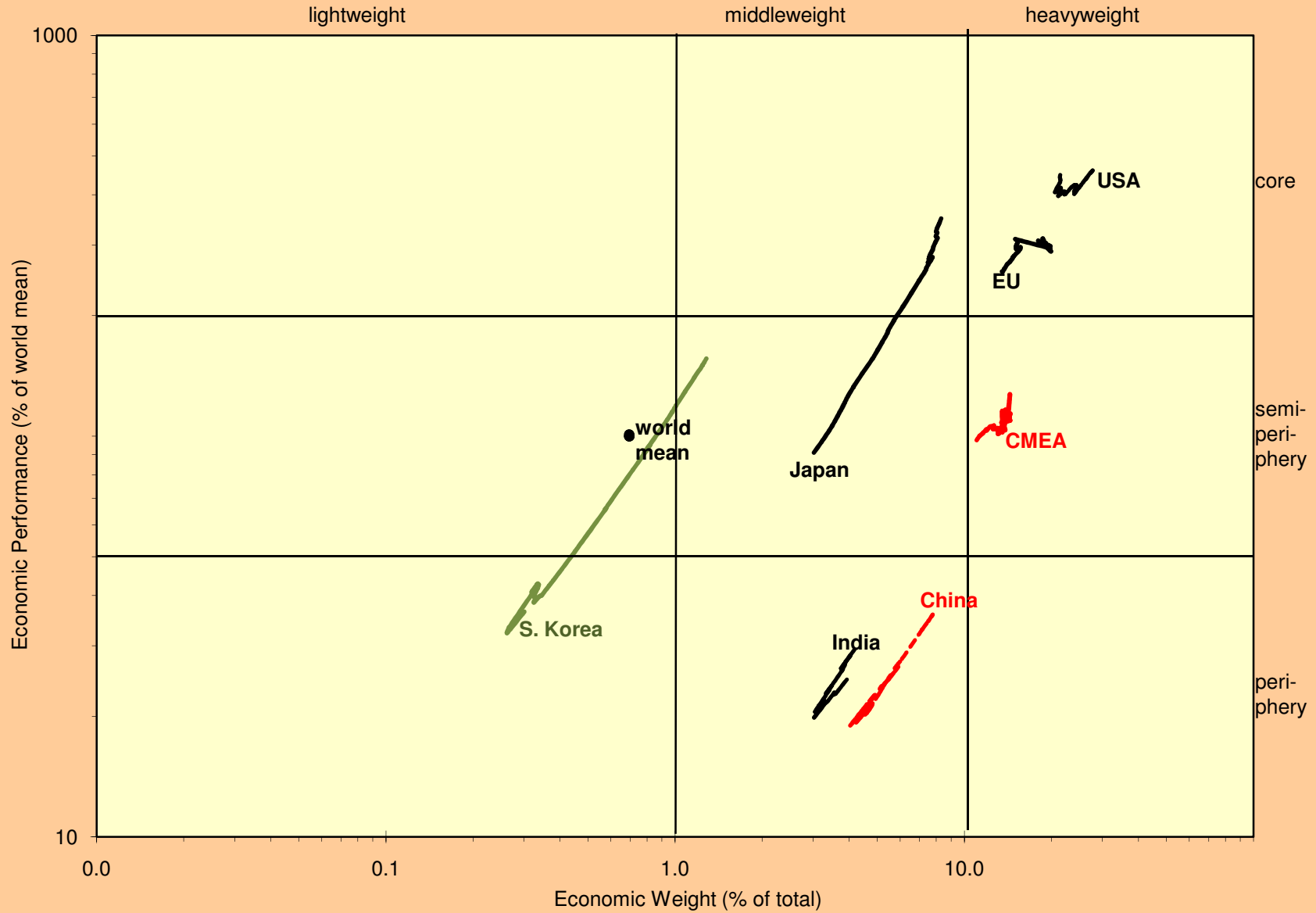


Figure 4. Trajectories of the Warsaw Pact, NATO, and Some of Their Main Competitors, GDP/cap as % of world mean by GDP as % share in total world GDP, 1955-1991 (Computed from Maddison 2001. Labels indicate earliest datapoint.)

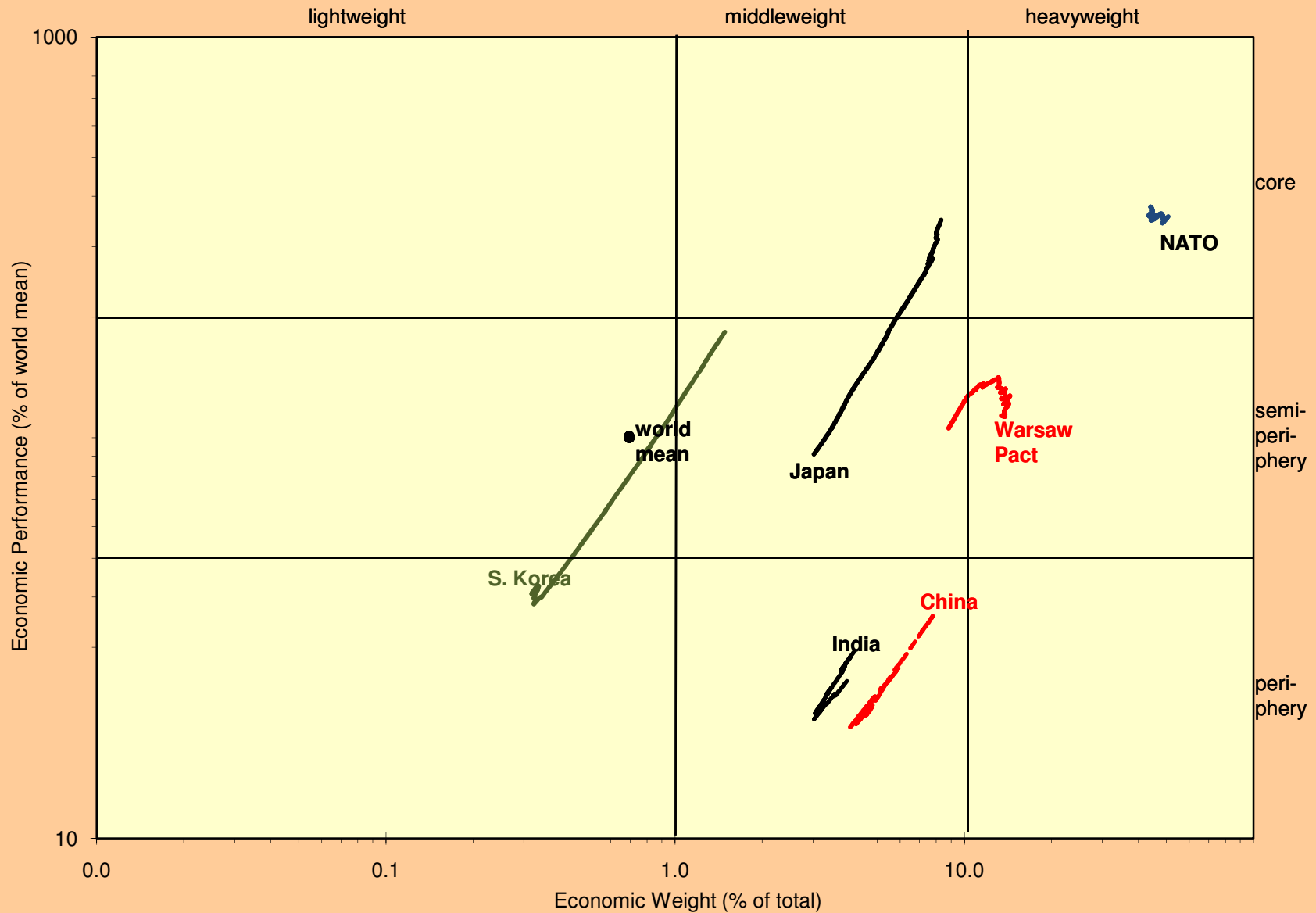

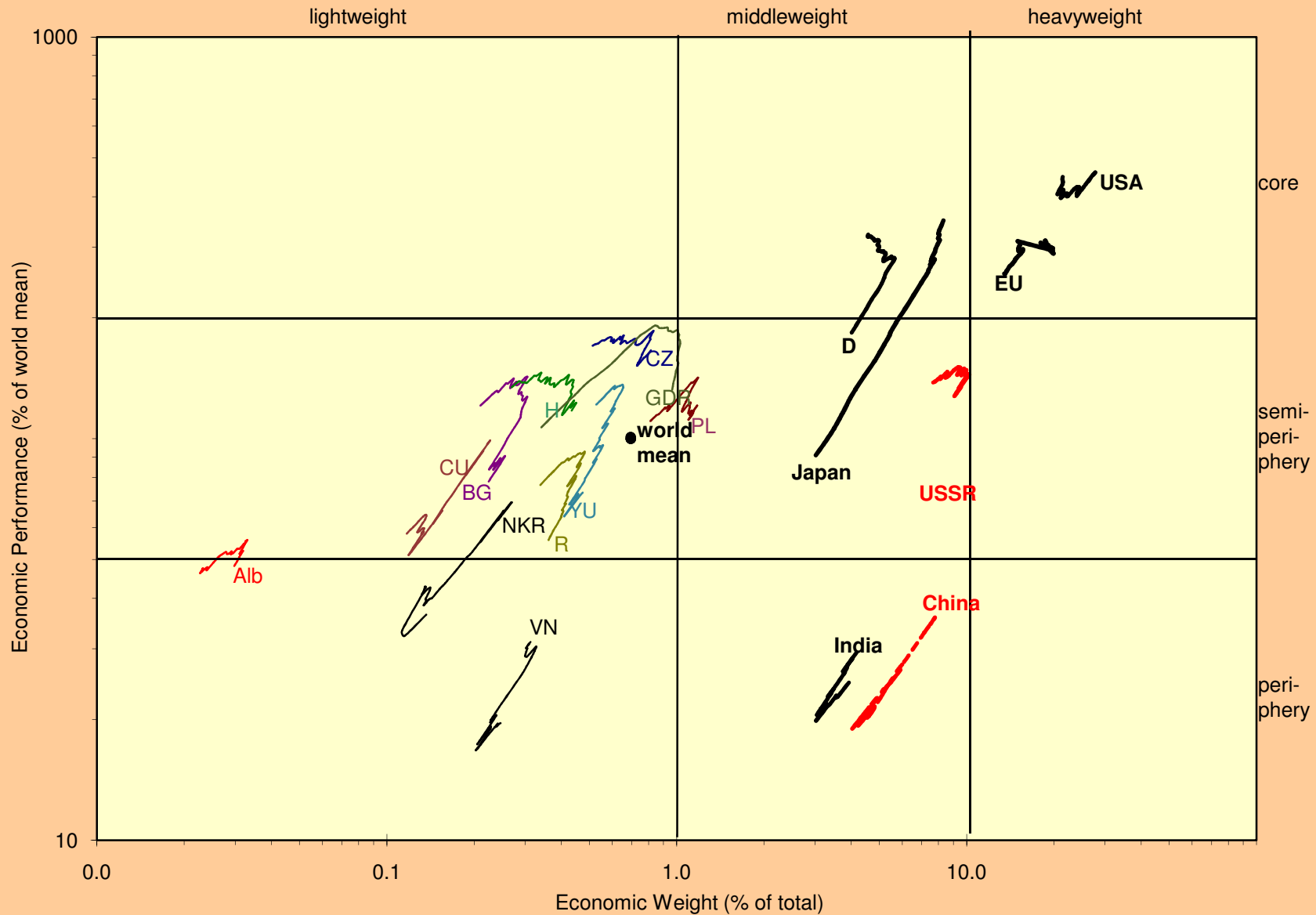

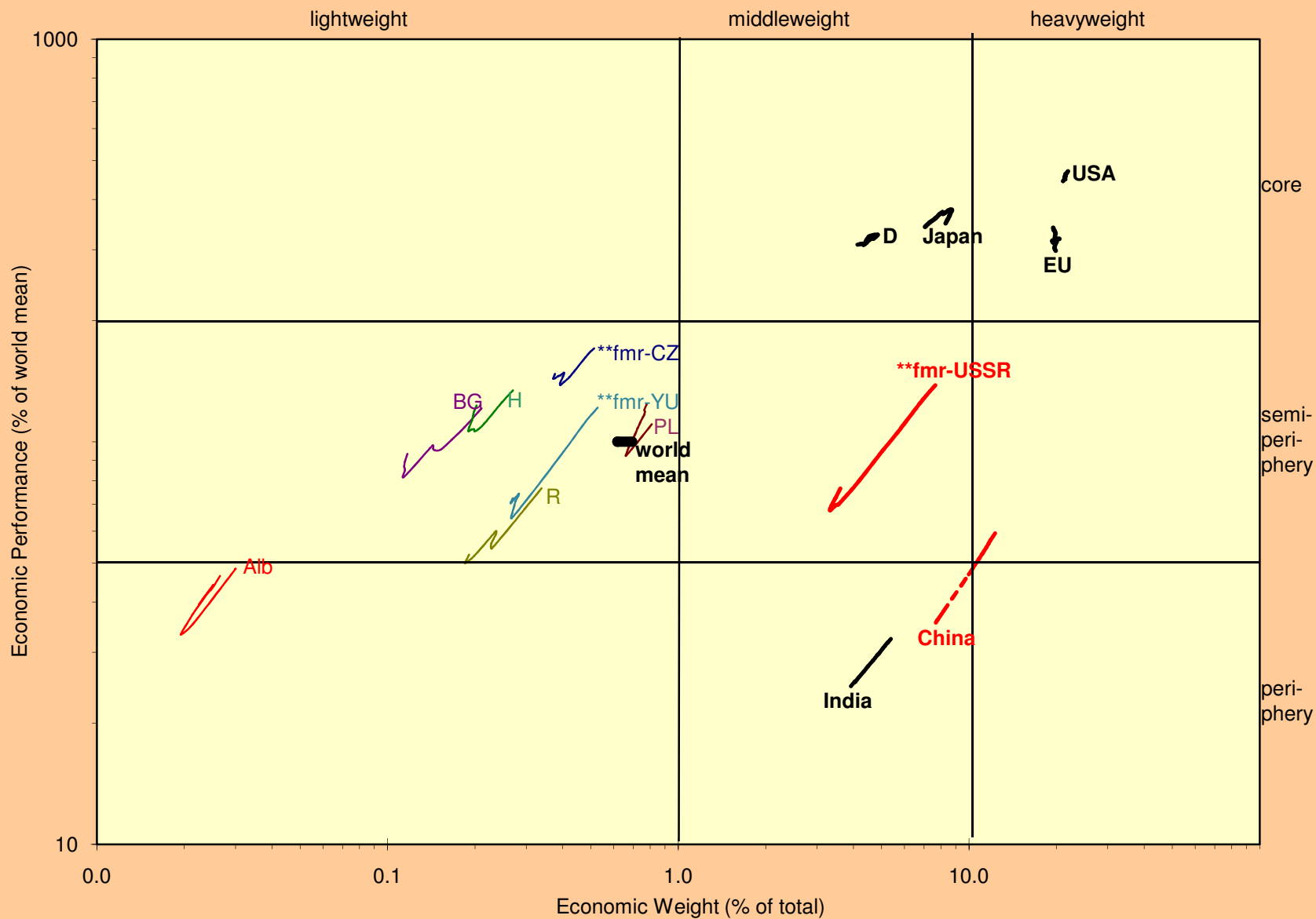

(Computed from Maddison 2001. Labels indicate earliest datapoint.)

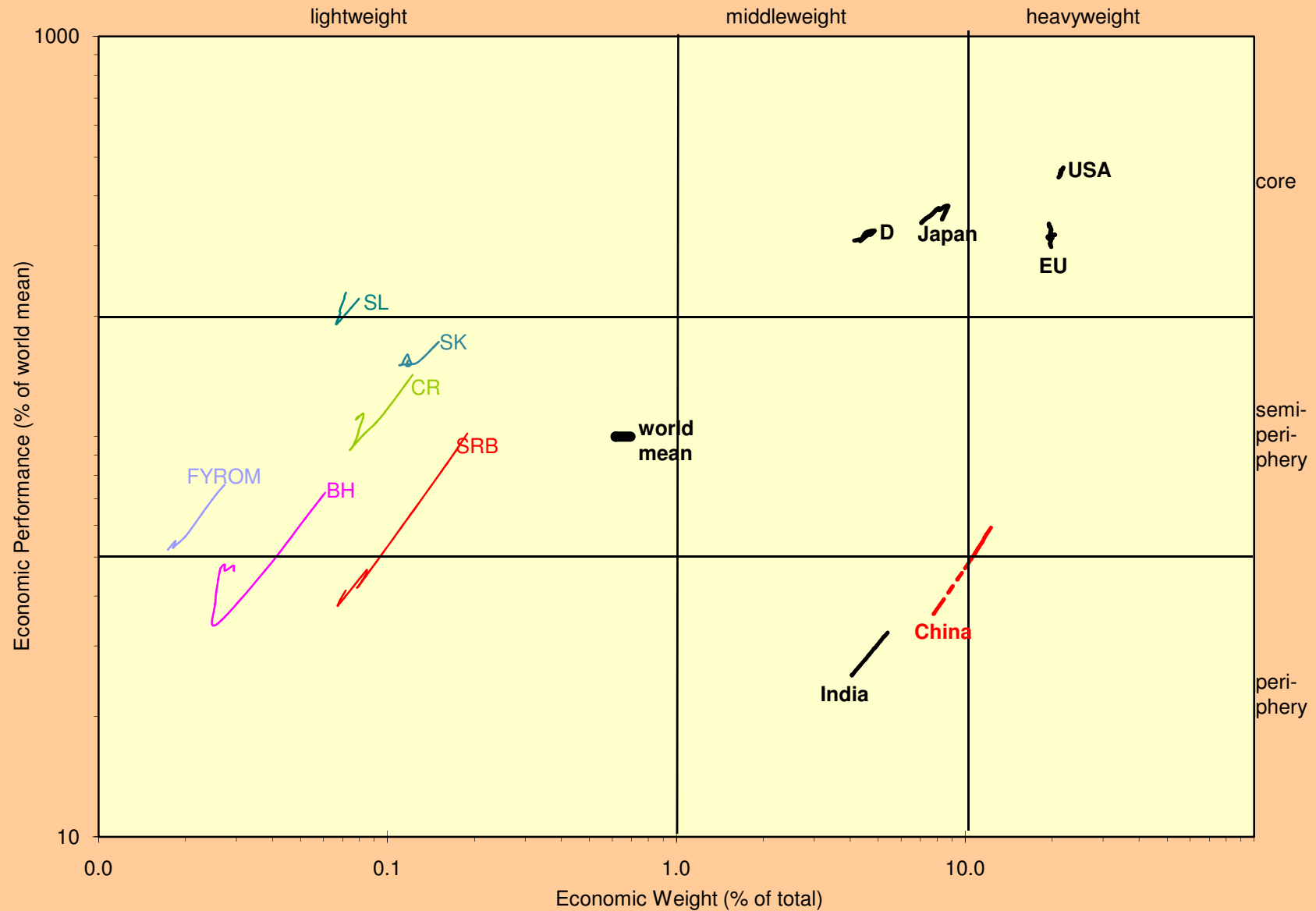
